At Temple Sinai there are so many ways to get involved . . .

Adult Education Committee: In cooperation with the Senior Rabbi, the committee researches, develops and implements programming and events to enhance the congregation's knowledge and understanding of all aspects of the Jewish experience.

Auction Committee: Plans Temple Sinai's Annual Benefit Auction, an evening of fun and fundraising, filled with amazing food, fantastic music and a wonderful collection of auction items.

Brotherhood: Promotes fellowship by helping to create a warm, caring men's community, which provides service and programs to the entire congregation, and the community at large.

Building, Grounds & House Committee: Oversees the maintenance of the building and grounds, and any new construction.

Caring Committee: Reaches out to those experiencing loss, grief, and life cycle crises as well as in special times of celebration and creates interlocking support networks for Temple members.

Chai Society: This lively social group plans a broad variety of events throughout the year as well as enriching Jewish educational experiences for its members.

Choir & Music Committee: In cooperation with the Cantor, assists in the development and enrichment of the Temple's musical activities.

Education Committee: Works closely with the Religious School Director to develop an excellent educational program which links our children to their Jewish heritage and fosters a life-long commitment to Jewish values and continued learning.

Friend of a Friend/Chaverot: Provides a social outreach program for women, which enhances their connection to the synagogue and Judaism. Also serves as a corps of volunteers dedicated to providing service and programs to the entire congregation as well as the community at large.

Fundraising Committee: Plans events to raise funds to support the general operating budget of the Temple.

Interfaith Outreach Committee: Welcomes interfaith families by creating opportunities for them to explore sensitive issues, ensuring the sensitivity of the Temple staff, and raising congregational awareness of the unique challenges and circumstances that they face.

Israel Committee: Supports Israel, global Jewish communities and Jewish organizations that directly impact on our Temple, Reform Judaism and the Jewish population.

Kulanu "All of Us" - LGBTQ Committee: Provides a welcoming atmosphere and support to the gay, lesbian, transgender and queer/questioning members of our congregation and to their families and friends.

Marketing & Communications Committee: Informs the congregation and the local community about all of Temple Sinai's programs, worship services and activities.

Membership Committee: Reaches out to Jewish families in the community to make them aware of the many ways that the Temple can enrich their lives, and creates a welcoming environment for new members.

Nursery School Committee: Works with the Nursery School Director to provide an outstanding program in a caring, nurturing environment where children grow intellectually, socially and emotionally and develop a strong Jewish identity and connection to our Temple.

Religious Affairs Committee: Works in close partnership with the clergy on all matters that relate to the religious life within the congregation.

Sinai in the City (SITC): Temple Sinai's young adults program that provides social and religious programming to individuals in the 20's and 30's. The group hosts its events in New York City.

Social Action Committee: Engages the Temple Sinai community in meaningful educational programs and acts of Tikkun Olam, which respond to the human needs around us. Performing mitzvot that reflect the ideals of Judaism is the focus of this committee.

Ushering Committee: Provides a warm, welcoming environment and maintains decorum and organization at all religious services.

Website Committee: For technology "mavens" to help maintain and improve our website.

Youth Engagement Committee: Works with the Director of Youth Engagement to develop a program that will involve as many youth as possible in high quality activities and events that will expose them to Jewish values and customs.
